SUBJECT: Approval of 2015-2016 School Accountability Report Cards

Background

In November 1988, California voters passed Proposition 98, also known as *The Classroom Instructional Improvement and Accountability Act*. This act requires all public schools in California to prepare annually School Accountability Report Cards (SARCs). The SARCs are intended to provide the public with important information about each public school and to communicate a school's progress in achieving its goals.

Discussion

All of the data-element requirements for SARCs were met by each of our schools. The SARCs reflect 2015-2016 data and demographics, as required by law. The public can access the SARCs on the district and individual school websites. Additionally, copies of SARCs are available at each of our schools and in the Office of Instructional Services.

Recommendation

Christiane Gervais, Assistant Superintendent, Instructional Services, recommends that the Board of Education approve the SARCs for the 2015-2016 school year.
