SUBJECT: Approval of Resolution No. 2016-2017-11: A Resolution for Adoption of a Plan to Consolidate Future Governing Board Member Elections with the Statewide General Election, Pursuant to Elections Code Section 14052(b)

Background

The District currently conducts its elections during off-cycle (odd-numbered) election years. Because there is historical evidence of low voter turnout in the District for school board elections, the District has begun the process of adopting a plan to consolidate its elections with the 2022 statewide general election. This matter was brought for Board discussion at the November 8, 2016 Board meeting, at which time Administration recommended the Board take action to begin the process of consolidation.

Discussion

The first step in the consolidation process is for the Board to approve a Resolution detailing the consolidation request to the Board of Supervisors. The passage of Resolution No. 2016-2017-10, satisfies that requirement. The passage of Resolution No. 2016-2017-11, provides the County Board of Supervisors with the plan by which the District Board of Education will move forward to complete the consolidation process.

Recommendation
